2020 Power Leaders in Real Estate (Part 2)

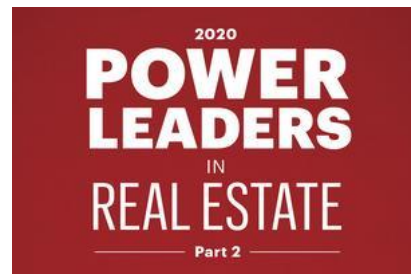
